Objective and Details of Eol

1. Introduction:

BEML, a 'schedule 'A' Company under Ministry of Defence, Govt. of India, plays a pivotal role and serves India's core sectors of Defence & Aerospace, Rail & Metro and Mining & Construction with four manufacturing complexes located at Bengaluru, Kolar Gold Fields (KGF), Mysuru and Palakkad.

All the manufacturing units of BEML have been accredited with ISO 9001 – 2000, ISO 14001 (HSC) and AS 9100D certifications. The Company has a nationwide Marketing Network and an International Business Division for Exports activity. Details of the BEML Ltd is available on www.bemlindia.in

2. Objective of Eol:

- 2.1.BEML intends to identify and collaborate with technically competent Collaborator (s) on development and manufacturing of Automated / Electro Hydraulic / Electro Pneumatic Ground Handling / Ground Support Equipment for Military & Civil Aviation.

5. Pre-Qualification Requirements (PQR):

7. Quality Requirements:

7.1. Applicant have valid Quality Management System (QMS) for "Development & Prove out" of GHE/GSEs for military aircrafts. Applicable military (MIL) standards shall be considered for development, handling, maintenance and special processes for corrosion prevention. Proper documentation shall be created, maintained and retained in line with QMS requirements, at every phases of product life cycle management. The analysis of BEML Design shall be carried out using appropriate licenced software's. During development phase, the Collaborator shall follow mandatory protocol for selection and qualification of materials and aggregates. Qualification of materials shall be from NABL/Government accredited laboratories. The fabrication shall follow approved processes, which need to be documented in the form of "Route Book" and certified at every stage before proceeding to next stage.

8. Selection Criteria:

- 8.1. Proposals from Applicants will be evaluated and shortlisted based on following criteria. Minimum qualification shall meet 80% of evaluation matrix (Annexure-II)
 - a) Technical Capability (50%)
 - b) Financial Strength (20%)
 - c) Past Performance and Experience (20%)
 - d) Innovative Solutions and R&D Capabilities (10%)
- 8.2. Language: All correspondences and documents related to the Eol response shall be in English language, provided that any printed literature furnished by the Prospective Collaborator may be written in another language, as long as such literature is accompanied by a translation of its pertinent passages in English language in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the bid, the English translation shall govern. However, if the translation is found to be incorrect subsequently, appropriate action as may be deemed fit shall be initiated against the Prospective Collaborator.
- 8.3. The Prospective Collaborator shall abide by the terms & conditions, as applicable, of the EoI.

- 8.9. The Applicant(s) should consider the following also while submitting the response to this EoI:
 - a. The Applicant may also be required to enter into a long-term Supply Agreement and meet the expected delivery requirements and other Terms
 & Conditions of RFP / Tender to be issued by BEML on cost basis.
 - b. Applicant should be willing to associate with BEML for conducting the Field Evaluation Trials conducted by various agencies.
 - c. The Applicant shall be required to provide the desired Unit(s) of Continuous Miner and Supporting Equipment for Field Evaluation Trials in varying climatic altitude and terrain conditions in India.
 - d. Applicant would be required to support BEML during interactions with the various agencies in India for initial screening, participation in the customer RFP / Tender and subsequent qualification process by way of deputing their experts to India and providing the required information and clarifications as required/sought by customer.

Above mentioned requirements are only indicative in nature, however any other document/information/input required by BEML for cost estimation and for preparation & submission of techno-commercial bid to customer shall have to be provided by the prospective partner.

9. Process To Be Confidential:

9.1. Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of EoI and recommendations shall not be disclosed to Prospective Collaborator. Any effort by Prospective Collaborator to influence BEML in processing of EoI or selection decisions may result in the rejection of the response against EoI.

10. Governing Laws & Jurisdiction:

- 10.1.The EoI process shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with the laws of Republic of India and the Courts at Bengaluru (India) shall have exclusive jurisdiction over all disputes arising under, pursuant to and / or in connection with the EoI process.
- 10.2. Foreign entity interested for collaboration with BEML must have necessary clearance from their Govt. for Technology Sharing & Collaboration.

11. Restrictions On Specified Transfer of Technology with An Entity from A Country Which Shares a Land Border with India:

11.1. Prospective Collaborator(s) from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to respond to this EoI only if Prospective Collaborator(s) is registered with Competent Authority (Registration Committee constituted by the Department of Promotion of Internal Trade (DPIIT) of Govt. of India). - registration should be at least valid for the entire period of EoI due date or any extension thereof.
- 11.2.Prospective Collaborator(s) from a country which shares a land border with India means: a) An entity incorporated, established or registered in such country; or b) A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established or registered in such country; or c) An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established or registered in such country; or d) An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or e) An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or f) A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or g) A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under any of the above.

12. Post Selection Conditions:

- 12.1.The Expression of Interest submitted by the Applicants will be evaluated and the Selected Collaborator(s) will be intimated in writing by BEML by way of an Acceptance Order ("Acceptance Order").
- 12.2.Post selection, BEML and the Selected Collaborator(s) shall execute a Non-Disclosure Agreement/MoU within one (1) week of release of Acceptance Order.

13. Rejection:

- 13.1. An Expression of Interest is liable to be rejected for any of the following conditions:
- 13.2. The Expression of Interest is not accompanied by required documentation and has failed to provide clarifications related thereto, when sought by BEML.
- 13.3. Misrepresentation, lack of proper documentation, fraud, coercion
- 13.4. The Expression of Interest is received after the closing time and date.
- 13.5.If any information which would have entitled BEML to reject or disqualify the applicant becomes known after the applicant has been qualified, it reserves the right to reject the applicant at that time or at any time after such information becomes known to BEML.
