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DETAILS OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

- 4.1 BEML is executing contract for design, manufacture, supply, testing and commissioning of High-Speed Trainsets for Mumbai Ahmedabad High Speed Rail (MAHSR) section.
- 4.2 The project is being developed and operated by National High Speed Rail Corporation Limited (NHSRCL). MAHSR is the first such high speed corridor undertaken by NHSRCL. Many other high-speed corridors have been proposed and are in different stages of approval. All such high-speed rail corridors would require reliable and efficient passenger rolling stock.

4.3 **Purpose**:

- 4.3.1 BEML is the front runner in supplying High-Speed Trainsets for 1st Indian corridor. Considering the future requirements in these high-speed corridors, BEML desires to partner with reputed Indian manufacturers and suppliers of propulsions and bogies for high-speed trainsets (operating speed of 249 kmph and above) on long terms basis.
- 4.3.2 BEML shall enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) with the selected Collaborator on an exclusive basis. The selected Collaborator shall be responsible for design, manufacture, supply, testing and commissioning of propulsion systems and bogies (including its AMC, if required); whereas BEML shall be responsible for design, manufacture, integration, testing, supply and commissioning (including its AMC if required) of car body, interiors, etc. required to form a complete trainset.
- 4.3.3 The proposed MoA shall contain overall framework of joint working of both parties to address the future tenders for high-speed trainsets (operating speed of 249 kmph and above) in India on exclusive basis. However, specific details for addressing each tender shall be dealt through specific Agreement pertaining to the tender.
- 4.4 This EoI document does not have any relation with respect to any of the previous EoI / RFI / RFP floated for similar activities.
- 4.5 This EoI document is not an offer and is issued with no commitment. BEML reserves the right to revise/withdraw/cancel the EoI or change or modify full or any part thereof at any stage.



- 4.6 Timeline and sequence of events resulting from this EoI shall ultimately be determined by BEML.
- 4.7 By submitting bid / offer in response to this EoI, each interested Prospective Collaborator shall be deemed to have acknowledged that it has carefully read all the terms & conditions of this EoI document, and has fully informed itself / himself / herself as to all existing terms and conditions.
- 4.8 The interested Prospective Collaborator shall abide by the terms & conditions of this Eol. [Please note that this is a fundamental condition of this Eol document and must be well understood and accepted by the interested Prospective Collaborator before participating in the Eol].
- 4.9 The person signing response to the EoI should have due written authorization from the Prospective Collaborator to sign the documents and should duly authenticate any errors or corrections in the EoI. Over writing should be avoided. All pages of the response against this EoI shall be duly signed by the authorised signatory. Copies of the credentials/ documents which are to be annexed must be self-attested and bear the signature and seal of the authorized signatory / authorised representative of the interested Entity/Firm/Company. The interested Prospective Collaborator will be requested to produce the originals of all information / documents as and when so required by BEML.
- 4.10 Multiple proposals from the same Prospective Collaborator should not be submitted.
- 4.11 BEML at its discretion shall inspect the Prospective Collaborator's works/ office/reference site premises for the purpose of evaluation, as deemed necessary before selection of Prospective collaborator. BEML's decision in this regard shall be final.
- 4.12 BEML shall receive responses pursuant to this EoI in accordance with the terms set forth herein, as modified, altered, amended and clarified from time to time by BEML and all responses shall be submitted in accordance with such terms on or before the date specified in this EoI for submission of responses.
- 4.13 The Eol and all correspondences and documents related to the Eol response shall be in English language, provided that any printed literature furnished by the interested Prospective Collaborator may be written in another language, as long as such literature is accompanied by a translation of its pertinent passages in English language in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the bid, the English translation shall govern.



However, if the translation is found to be incorrect subsequently, appropriate action as may be deemed fit shall be initiated against the Prospective Collaborator.

- 4.14 The Prospective Collaborator should not subcontract the work related to the agreed scope of work without prior written consent from BEML.
- 4.15 The Prospective Collaborator shall provide the number of resources required for development of the work during different phases with necessary technical capabilities.
- 4.16 The personnel of Prospective Collaborator must adhere to all the safety guidelines while handling/ manufacturing equipment, machinery, components etc. All the safety gadgets procurement and issue shall be within the scope of work and responsibility of the Selected Prospective Collaborator.
- 4.17 <u>Eol Process to be confidential</u>: Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of Eol and recommendations shall not be disclosed to Prospective Collaborator(s). Any effort by Prospective Collaborator(s) to influence BEML in processing of Eol or selection decisions may result in the rejection of the response against Eol.
- 4.18 <u>Governing Law & Jurisdiction</u>: The Eol process shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with the laws of Republic of India and shall be subject to exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts at Bengaluru (India).
- 4.19 The terms and conditions as stated in this EoI document are not exhaustive and BEML reserves the right to add or delete or modify any terms and condition of this EoI in the RFP/MoA.

4.22 Rejection:

An Expression of Interest is liable to be rejected for any of the following conditions:

- 4.22.1 The Expression of Interest is not accompanied by required documentation and has failed to provide clarifications related thereto, when sought by BEML.
- 4.22.2 Misrepresentation, lack of proper documentation, fraud, coercion, undue influence, canvassing etc., by the prospective collaborator/applicant
- 4.22.3 The Expression of Interest is received after the closing time and date.
- 4.22.4 Any information which would have entitled BEML to reject or disqualify the prospective collaborator/applicant becomes known to BEML after the prospective collaborator/applicant has been qualified
- 4.23 The Prospective Collaborator should agree to sign the "Integrity Pact" with BEML in the format provided by BEML committing the persons / officials of both the parties, not to exercise any corrupt practices on any aspect of the EoI, selection, joint working / future contract (as per the provisions of the BEML Purchase Manual).
