Details of Expression of Interest (Eol)

4.1. Introduction:

BEML invites application/response to this Expression of Interest (Eol) from reputed Indian MSMEs / Firms / Companies / Contractors for the purpose of empanelling as "Prospective Collaborator" for providing customised dredging solutions & execution of dredging activity for its valuable customer like NHPC, IWAI, GSL, CSL, HSL, GMDC, Karnataka state Maritime Board & all other state maritime boards, MDL, NSRY, Port, Harbour, other shipyards & Dockyards etc.

4.2. Preamble:

BEML is seeking industrial partners/collaborators who are proficient in the execution of customised dredging solutions, hydro-suction, sediment removal, and allied marine operations on a turnkey basis, with the objective of enabling BEML to expand its service capabilities and meet the growing demands of its customers.

4.3. Scope of Co-operation:

4.3.1 BEML reserves the right to onboard multiple eligible firms (More than one firm) for the mentioned EOI. Limited tender will be floated among the onboarded empanelled firms, on 'case-to-case' basis, prior to placing the final work/service contract/ Purchase order. NDA/MoU may be entered into with the prospective collaborator.

4.3.2 The broad scope of work includes, but is not limited to the following key activities:

4.3.2.1 For removal, transportation & disposal of soft/ hard silt, deposited Sediments from any River/ Pond/ Lake/ Port/ Harbour/ Shipyard/ Dockyard/ Sea/ Reservoir on PAN India basis.

4.3.2.2 Sediment Removal and Disposal: This involves the comprehensive removal and appropriate disposal of various types of sediments, including silt, sand, clay, pebbles, cobbles, and boulders etc. The critical aspect of this component is the identification and allocation of suitable disposal areas. The firm will be solely responsible for obtaining all requisite permissions for disposal from the concerned agencies /departments of the State Government and the Central Government (if required) including all statutory compliances. Furthermore, upon the successful completion of the work, the restoration of the disposal and working sites to their original or improved condition will fall within the scope of the Firm.

4.3.2.3 Disposal Logistics and Site Management: This entails the meticulous site identification and allocation for the positioning of all necessary equipment and machinery. It also includes securing the necessary permissions for their parking and movement within and along the designated work areas. Similar to sediment disposal sites, the post completion site restoration of these equipment / machinery parking and movement areas shall be the responsibility of the Firm.

4.3.2.4 Accurate Measurement and Verification: To ensure transparency and accurate quantification of work completed; periodic surveys are mandatory. This includes topographic, hydrographic, and bathymetric surveys, as well as measurements using velocity / flow meters and density meters to accurately assess the dredging quantity. A standardized and validated measurement methodology will be jointly finalized to establish the precise volume of solid sediment removed. For measurement purpose, the quantity of sediment disposed shall be

informed to BEML by the firm through the assessment recorded by the concerned Department of respective Client.

4.4.3 This Eol is not an offer and is issued with no commitment. BEML reserves the right to Revise/withdraw/Cancel the Eol or change or modify full or any part thereof at any stage.

4.4.4 BEML also reserves the sole right and discretion to disqualify Prospective Collaborator, should it be so necessary at any stage.

4.4.5 Timeline and sequence of events resulting from this Eol shall ultimately be determined by BEML.

4.4.6 By submitting response to this Eol, the Prospective Collaborator shall deem to have acknowledged that it has carefully read all the terms & conditions of this

Eol document, and has fully understood / informed himself/herself as to all existing terms and conditions.

4.4.7 Multiple proposals by the same Perspective Collaborator should not be submitted.

4.4.8 BEML, at its discretion, may inspect the Prospective Collaborator's works/ office/reference site premises etc. for evaluation, as deemed necessary before the selection of the Prospective Collaborator. BEML's decision in this regard shall be final.

4.4.9 BEML shall receive responses pursuant to this Eol in accordance with the terms set forth herein, as may be modified, altered, amended, and clarified from time to time by BEML and all responses shall be submitted in accordance with such terms on or before the date specified in this Eol for submission of responses.

4.4.10 The Selected Prospective Collaborator should agree for not subcontracting the work related to the agreed scope of work without prior written approval from BEML.

4.4.11 The Prospective Collaborator should agree to provide the number of resources required for the development of the work during different phases with necessary technical capabilities.

4.4.12 The Prospective Collaborator should agree that, his personnel must adhere to all the safety guidelines while handling equipment, machinery, components etc. All the safety gadgets procurement and issue shall be within the scope of work and responsibility of the Selected Prospective Collaborator.

4.4.13 Language: All correspondences and documents related to the Eol response shall be in English language, provided that any printed literature furnished by the Prospective Collaborator may be written in another language, as long as such literature is accompanied by a translation of its pertinent passages in English language in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the bid, the English translation shall govern. However, if the translation is found to be incorrect

subsequently, BEML will have right to take appropriate action against the Prospective Collaborator as may be deemed fit.

4.4.14 The person signing the response to the EoI should have due written authorization from the Prospective Collaborator to sign the documents and should duly authenticate any errors or corrections in the EoI. Over writing should be avoided. Copies of the credentials/ documents which are to be annexed must be self-attested and bear the signature and seal of the authorized signatory / authorised representative of the interested Entity / Firm / Company. The interested Entity / Firm / Company will be requested to produce the originals of all information / documents as and when so required by BEML.

4.4.15 Any Prospective Collaborator which has been declared insolvent, bankrupted, debarred/blacklisted by Central/State Governments of India or by any entity controlled by Central/State Governments of India from participating in any of their project/tender, as on date of submission of EoI, shall not be eligible to submit the EoI.

4.4.16 The prospective collaborator on award of projects/ contracts should agree to provide necessary documents / reports, prepared for bathymetric surveys, hydrographic charts, topographic reports, operational logs, updated site layouts, project schemes and any other communication or operational data generated during the execution of projects/ contracts.

4.5 Submission and Process of EoI Evaluation:

4.5.1 The Prospective Collaborator meeting the qualification requirements as specified in Annexure-2 are invited to submit their response to this EoI.

4.5.2 Upon receipt of response(s) against this EoI, BEML will review the response(s) through a Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) to ascertain suitability and shortlist Prospective Collaborator for further discussions.

4.5.3 On evaluation, only selected Prospective Collaborator will be informed about their shortlisting.

4.6. **REJECTION:** An Expression of Interest is liable to be rejected for any of the following conditions:

4.6.1 The Expression of Interest is not accompanied by required documentation and has failed to provide clarifications related thereto, when sought by BEML.

4.6.2 Misrepresentation, lack of proper documentation, fraud, coercion, undue influence, canvassing etc., by the prospective collaborator.

4.6.3 The Expression of Interest is received after the closing time and date.
