### BEML's Performance Highlights And Future Road Map



I am delighted to share with you some of the performance highlights of BEML. We achieved an impressive 67% increase in our PBT which is the highest in the last seven years. This was achieved with increased business and continued focus on cost control. Amidst stiff competition, 83% of sales was achieved from orders obtained through competition mode. We have maintained a major

market share in Dozers and Dumpers market of Mining & Construction equipment.

In-house R&D took many initiatives for design and development of high technology products, aggregates and upgradation of existing products in all the business verticals.

In the Defence vertical under 'Make in India' initiative, Medium Bullet Proof Vehicle (MBPV) and 155mm Mounted Gun System were developed and showcased at DEFEXPO 2018

The Mining & Construction vertical saw trial-cum-sale Order for in-house designed and developed High End Dump Trucks (BH150E and BH205E), and orders for other High End products viz. Dozers (BD475-1), Excavators (BE1800D) are being pursued.

A road map has been drawn to maximize our geo-strategic reach, minimize import bill, increase domestic production capacity, integrate innovation & research through 'Centers of Excellence' to drive integrated R&D, we are collaborating with other CPSEs on specific R&D projects and leverage technology platforms.

BEML has achieved level of indigenization over 90% in the mainline M&C products, Rail Coaches & EMU's, over 80% in High Mobility Vehicles (HMV) and over 67% in Metro cars. Various Digital initiatives like 100% digitization of all business activities for payments and receipts have been implemented.

Sustainability and Social Responsibility are an integral part of our business strategy. We have brought in a wider perspective to Corporate Social Responsibility and Sustainability through various programs on health, education, Swachh Bharat Campaign, skill-building, reducing carbon emissions etc.

We are looking forward to bring in increasing thrust on import substitution through indigenization and the Makein-India initiative has opened up many opportunities.

Metro Rail projects have been planned in a number of Metro & Non-Metro cities in India as part of urban development programme and should provide steady growth opportunities for the Company. Sub-urban trains are also graduating to IGBT-based 3 phase electrics and BEML is geared up to supply first set of Main Line Electric Multiple Units during current year. Maintenance equipment requirements are also increasing for Overhead

Inspection Cars, Track Laying, Rail Grinding & Track Cleaning Machines.

Significantly, BEML has received developmental orders for supply of 20 sets of LHB shells and Bogies.

The new Public Procurement Policy announced by GoI is an impetus for local manufacturers by way of eligibility to address the surging Metro Market in India. In such a scenario, the Company will focus on emerging new business opportunities including Medium / High Speed Coaches and also in developing new products / aggregates to align with the market requirements.

We are planning to enter into highend Mining Equipment, Continuous Miner & Mine Cruiser and also in design & development of Rope Shovels through in-house R&D/Partnership. With government's increased emphasis on infrastructure projects, the demand for construction equipment is going up which augurs well for Company.

BEML has taken various measures towards availability of spare parts, service support and has opened three new Service Centers / Spare Parts depots at Jodhpur, Likabali and Pune to support our Defence Forces. We are working with other DPSUs for supply of launching vehicles and aggregates for various missile programs and aerospace components. Further, development of 1500 HP engine for defence application which will be first of its kind in India, is under progress.

We will continue to pursue international business opportunities for increase in exports and are in the process of augmenting distributor network in identified countries for supplying Rail & Metro and Defence Equipments in addition to Mining & Construction equipments.

BEML's vision is to emerge as a strong player in each of its three business verticals. Towards that end, we need to stay mindful and responsive to corporate governance developments and continually review the Company's rules and regulations to ensure a transparent, fair and corruption free operational environment.

The dump truck weighs 335 Tons when fully loaded and is easily maneuverable with power-steering with a short turning radius. Emphasis has been given to operators comfort while designing the machine and it has an ergonomically designed dash board and tiltable telescopic steering wheel. Other salient features of the truck include good visibility in addition to safety features with provisions for emergency steering, breaking and proximity warning.

This dump truck has eco-friendly emission certified engine with electronic fuel management system to deliver maximum power and GE AC propulsion system to give consistent performance in steep gradients. Its wide body design, higher volumetric capacity and a low loading height ensures high stability and productivity.

### BEML manufactured first six coach Metro flagged off

In a major relief for passengers travelling the crowded metro trains, BMRCL six coach metro was flagged off by Shri H.D. Kumara Swamy, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Karnataka on June 22,2018.

Addressing the gathering as a special guest, Shri Hota, said "We will deliver the coaches within the deadline". We were given orders during 2016 and 18 month period is generally given for such contracts. Due to the urgent requirement for it we delivered it

by February 2017. Round-the-clock effort by BEML and excellent co-ordination at every stage by BMRCL helped us achieve it."

With addition of 3 coaches, each train now be able to carry 1950 passengers almost double the capacity of 975.

In March last year, BEML won the Rs 1421 crores order to supply 150 sets of intermediate cars to expand 3 car train by June 2019. This will convert all three – car trains to six by the end of next year.

## **BEML Unveiled 8 Wheeler Diesel Electric Tower Car (8W DETC)**

BEML has unveiled the 8W DETC (Self Propelled 8 Wheeler Diesel Electric Inspection & Maintenance OHE Tower Car) for Indian Railways. At a function held at Bangalore Complex on 2nd Aug. 18, Shri Deepak Kumar Hota, CMD flagged off the OHE Car.

"The new 8W DETC has a good demand from Indian Railways and BEML has developed the product with indigenous technology, thus adding yet another prestigious product of BEML to comply with 'Make in India policy of the Government', said Shri Hota, during the flagging off Equipment.

The Tower car is equipped with a lifting and swiveling platform powered by DG set for maintenance of overhead equipment, provision for carrying all necessary equipments for maintenance. It also has the capability for a cable pay-out arrangement and portable generator cum welding machine for night operations. It boasts of a portable infra-red thermal imaging camera for monitoring the hot spot temperature of over-head equipments.

The vehicle is fitted with an intercom system for communication between operating staff / crew members and a CC TV surveillance system to monitor the roof-top activities from cabin.

The 8W DETC is an electric version vehicle intended for using Indian Railways for inspection, Patrolling and maintenance of traction overhead equipment.
