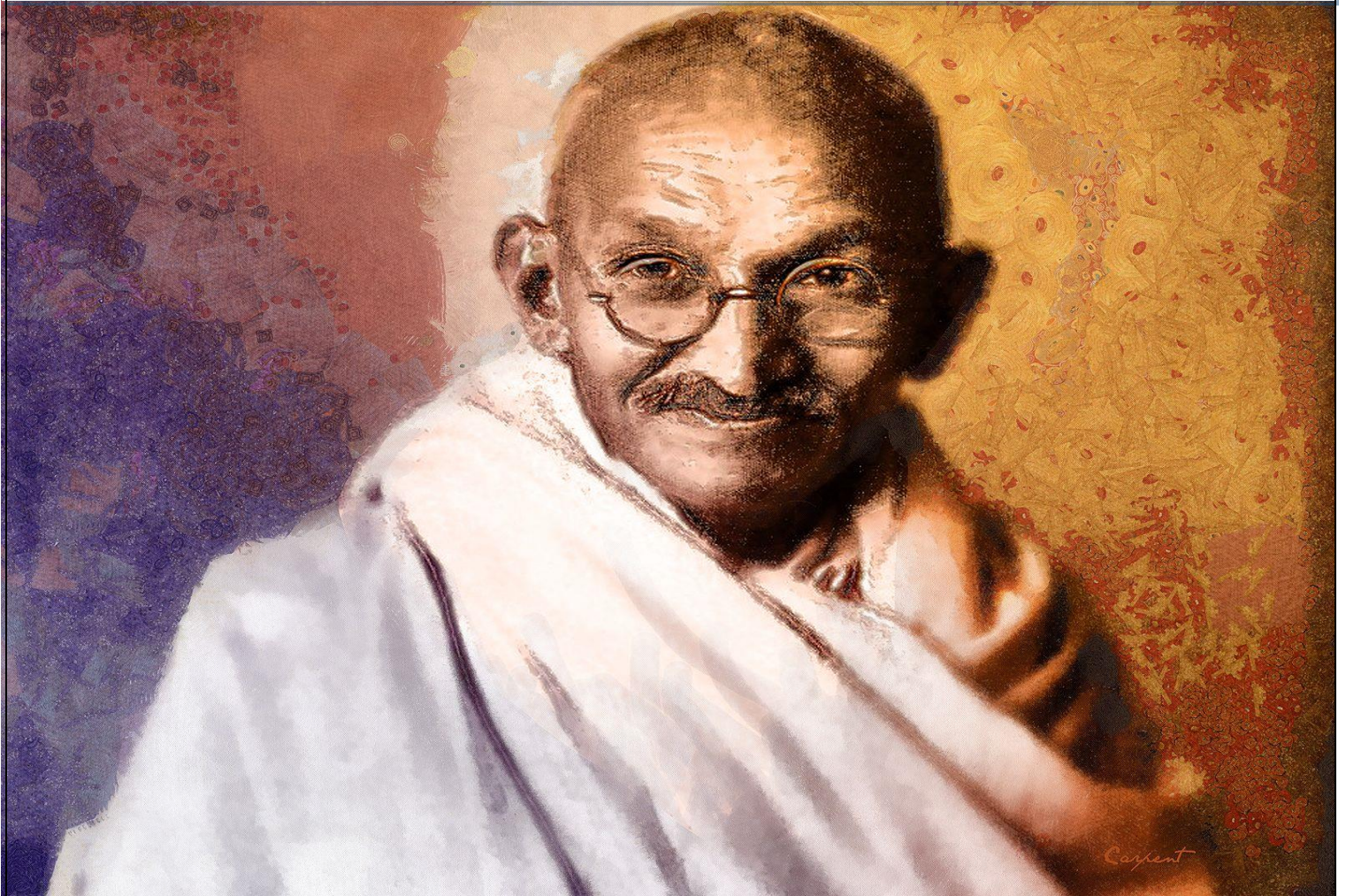


SWACHHTA PAKHWADA
